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RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY  
OF THE  
WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE  
Resolution No. WR-02-2020

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE THAT:

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Walker River Paiute Tribe of Nevada is organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, to exercise certain rights of home rule and be responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare of its members, and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe is a federally recognized by the United States Government and the Secretary of the Interior as a Native American Tribe, and by the power vested in the Tribal Constitution and Bylaws, the Council has the Authority to enter into contracts and administer any funds with the control of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe, vested all powers inherent in the execution of the Walker River Indian Paiute Reservation to remedy bad housing conditions, eliminate housing shortages, over-crowding conditions and provide low and moderate-income tribal member families opportunities for acceptable shelter and improvements to social and economic well-being; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe operates a program known as the Housing Improvement Program with funds provided by the Bureau of Indian Affairs under Public Law 93-638 contract which is governed by 25 CFR Part 256 Subchapter K, Housing; and

WHEREAS, under Public Law 93-638, the Walker River Paiute Tribe must rank and approve applicants' criteria under 25 CFR 256 or under a tribally designated program; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Housing Department has ranked applicants in accordance with the approved regulations and tribal amendments and ranking are shown on attached list; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the attached Bureau of Indian Affairs, Housing Improvement Program Priority List for 2020, a new list shall be made of eligible applicants each year.

CERTIFICATION

It is hereby certified that the foregoing resolution of the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council of the Walker River Paiute Tribe composes of seven members, of whom 7, constituting a quorum were present at a meeting held on the 9th day of January 2020, and that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of 5 FOR and 0 AGAINST and 1 ABSTENTIONS, pursuant to the authority contained in Article VI, Section I(e), of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Walker River Paiute Tribe of Nevada, approved on March 26, 1937.
