### RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE

#### RESOLUTION WR-06-2020

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE THAT:**

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the Walker River Paiute Tribe is organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 1934 as amended, to exercise certain home rule and be responsible for the promotion of economic and social welfare of its members; and

**WHEREAS**, water plays a primary role in economic development and is of great cultural and spiritual wellbeing of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Water Quality Department is administering an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) 106 Water Pollution Grant under the Clean Water Act to assess and monitor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribe has gained the status of Financial Assistance for Program Eligibility under the Clean Water Act; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council is in full support of submitting a continuing CWA Section 106 grant application for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021, together, with all assurances, in the approximate amount of \$164,520.00, to the Region IX office of EPA; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council does authorize the Chairman, Vice Chairman, or designated representative to enter into, negotiate, and execute an agreement with the EPA, Region IX office and that the authorities of the resolution remain in effect until such time that this grant is closed, renegotiated, or amended.
