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RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY

Resolution No. WR -09- 2020

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE THAT:

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, to exercise certain rights off home rule and Be responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare of its member; an

WHEREAS, the Walker River Tribal Council is responsible for establishing a system of human resource Administration for the Walker River Paiute Tribe Four Seasons Market; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed Walker River Paiute Tribe Four Seasons Market amendment for an on- call person on page 11, also, amend the Full-Time - works a full time, normal work week of less than 30 hours to be in compliance with ACA, of the current Personnel and Procedure Guide of 2008 that provides information on Walker River Tribe Four Seasons Market objectives, recruitment, benefits, policies and procedures and establishes a system to recruit, select, develop, and maintain an effective and responsible workforce.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the Walker River Paiute Tribe amendment into the Personnel Policies and Procedures of 2008 attached hereto; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Walker River Paiute Tribal Enterprise Personnel Policies and Procedure Guide of 2008 shall not be construed in any way as a waiver of the Tribe's sovereign immunity; and,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this new amendment into the Personnel and Policies of 2020 supersede all prior Policies and actions previously adopted or taken to address human resource issues arising within the Walker River Paiute Tribe Four Seasons Market; and,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the amended policies are in effect as of the date and shall remain in effect until rescinded or amended by the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council.
