BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE THAT:

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Walker River Paiute Tribe of Nevada is organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984), as amended, to exercise certain rights of home rule and be responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare of its members, and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe of Nevada is authorized under Public Law 93-638 to request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to enter into contracts for services and programs on behalf of their constituency; and

WHEREAS, the youth of Walker River Paiute Tribe represents a great natural resource, and

WHEREAS, today's youth of Walker River Paiute Tribe will be leaders of tomorrow, and

WHEREAS, the youth need leadership training and experience to better prepare them for these important roles, and

WHEREAS, the youth should be given the opportunity to bring about positive changes in the existing conditions of the Walker River Paiute Tribal Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the young people between the ages of twelve to twenty-four should have a greater voice in the matters concerning them, and

WHEREAS, the youth, through their collective action, can serve as a catalyst to bring about more unity and harmony within the Walker River Paiute Tribe, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a mechanism which will allow for the distribution of information, coordination of activities, and sharing of resources, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for interaction and communication among the youth representing the various schools and communities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council that the spiritual, mental, physical and social well-being of our youth is of the highest priority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in order to provide a greater voice for our youth and to give them greater opportunities to develop as leaders, the Walker River Paiute Tribe authorizes the formation of the Numu Youth Council. This organization will operate under the supervision and with the support and encouragement of the Walker River Paiute Tribe.

NOW BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Walker River Paiute Tribe supports and approves the Numu Youth Council to join the UNITY Network, sponsored by United National Indian Tribal Youth, Inc. in an effort to bring about positive change in Native America and to provide youth with greater opportunities to work with other youth leaders throughout the nation.
