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RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. WR-20-2020

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE THAT:

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Walker River Paiute Tribe is organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 1934 as amended, to exercise certain home rule and be responsible for the promotion of economic and social welfare of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe is committed to protecting tribal trust resources, economies, infrastructure, human health and welfare against the impacts of extreme events and harmful environmental trends on the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe is fully committed in planning for climate change and passed the Tribe's Climate Adaptation Plan in 2018 setting priorities in dealing with climate change; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Walker River Paiute Tribe wishes to submit a grant proposal through the BIA's Tribal Resilience Program under the Category 3: Travel Support-Adaptation Planning to be able to attend training and technical workshops to build knowledge and skills for resilience to further develop the Tribe's Climate Adaptation Plan and plan project implementation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such BIA Grant application will be submitted for an amount not to exceed \$15,000; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Chairman, Vice-Chairman or authorized representative to submit such grant

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proposal and application for Tribal Resilience Program funding and that all necessary documents, forms and requirements will be signed accordingly.

CERTIFICATION
