RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY

RESOLUTION NO. WR-29-2019

AMENDMENT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE THAT:

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Walker River Paiute Tribe is organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 1934 as amended, to exercise certain home rule and be responsible for the promotion of economic and social welfare of its members; and

*WHEREAS, the above noted resolution was amended on February 18, 2020 with the following:*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the total amount used for emergency needs in 2019 was \$7,230.17; leaving a balance of \$42,769.83, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the funding from these emergency funds were identified for use in hiring Hilary Tompkins, a Partner with Hogan Lovells' Law Firm out of Washington, DC to assist the Tribe with Navy issues in the amount of \$10,000.00 at a special Tribal Council meeting that was held on January 24, 2020 via of Resolution WR-10-2020, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, there is a balance of \$32,769.83 funding remaining in this account for emergency needs for the 2020 year, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT, the Tribal Council hereby requests that such balance from the original \$50,000.00, that was allocated from the Tribe's Ramah Settlement (BIA Contract Support) funds, for such immediate and emergency water related needs on our reservation remain for identified emergency uses in 2020.

AMENDMENT CERTIFICATION

It is hereby certified that the foregoing Resolution of the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council, composed of seven members, of whom 4, constituting a quorum, were present at a meeting held on the 18th day of February, 2020, and that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, and 0 ABSTENTIONS, pursuant to the authority contained in Article VI, Section 1(e), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Walker River Paiute Tribe, approved March 26, 1937.
