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RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE

RESOLUTION WR-45-2020

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE THAT:

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Walker River Paiute Tribe is organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, to exercise certain rights of home rule and be responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe has the responsibility to provide for the health, social welfare and protection of its membership and to ensure police protection is provided to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe has received notification of the availability of funding from the B.I.A. Indian Highway Safety Program - FY 2021 for the foregoing purpose of traffic safety and the related activities through funding for position hours; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe is experiencing the problems of increased traffic through and within the Reservation and


WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribe lacks the additional funding to provide for the hiring of Highway Safety Officers; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Walker River Paiute Tribe will develop an application to the B.I.A. Indian Highway Safety Program for- FY 2021 Indian Highway Safety Program to receive funding for retaining our two current IHSP funded Officers and associated equipment. The total amount for the grant period is \$300,000; and

FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED, that the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council does authorize the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, or designated representative to enter into, negotiate, and execute the required documents of the grant application.

CERTIFICATION
