RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE RESOLUTION NO. WR-51-2020

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE THAT:

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Walker River Paiute Tribe (“Tribe”) is organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June, 1934, as amended, to exercise certain rights of home rule and to be responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council is charged with the responsibility of establishing policy, taking action to protect the peace and safety of Tribal members; and taking action to provide administrative guidelines based on the provisions of the Tribe’s Constitution and Bylaw, and in the exercise of the Tribe’s inherent powers; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe owns and operates the Four Seasons Market, and has recently experienced a number of customers exhibiting behavior that is detrimental to the business and places employees and other customers at risk; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that a process must be implemented to limit such activities and to protect employees, customers and the public;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Walker River Tribal Council hereby adopts the attached Four Seasons Market Banned Patron Policy, which shall go into effect immediately.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Chairwoman of the Walker River Paiute Tribe, or her designee in her absence, is hereby authorized to take any actions necessary to execute the intentions of this Resolution.
